Finance

Our troop relies on two areas on contribution to run the troop; annual dues and the holiday wreath sale. Each year we evaluate the costs from the prior year and set goals accordingly and are committed to working with the scouts on how to schedule activities and set budgets.

Dues

\$50 per scout due October 24th, includes annual BSA registration, insurance fees, and the average cost of advancement recognition.

Wreath Sale

The commission structure for the wreath sales has been changed to offer a higher return to the scout account for top sellers – this will be outlined in the wreath sale meeting on October 21st. We sell wreaths to support the program of the troop including the cost of insurance and property tax as well as patches, leadership material, courts of honor, and other program related expenses.

There has been discussion about a second fundraiser early in 2012 to directly support scouts attending summer camp. We want your thoughts and ideas.
