New From BSA

Effective January 1, 2010 all registered members (scouts and adults) will be required to have the new Annual Physical form on file with the Troop. If you don't already have the new form on file a link can be found on our web site in the Resources section.

Effective June 1, 2010 all registered adult Leaders, Committee Members, and Merit Badge Counselors are required to take Youth Protection every 2 Years. Adults without a current Youth Protection certificate on file will not be included in the re-charter registration in November.
